

Twinning Project
“Achieving the highest safety and technical quality of construction“



Twinning project “Achieving highest safety and technical quality of construction” aims on support to the process of the adoption and implementation of the Eurocodes in Montenegro. An important part of this task is strengthening of the co-operation in the area of Eurocodes in the region and establishing of a network sharing the already available documents and data and looking for synergies in that work.

On 21st November 2012 took place at the Ministry of Sustainable Development and Tourism a regional meeting between secretaries of the technical committees on Eurocodes from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia.

It has been agreed, that it is of big importance and interest to exchange the available national annexes to Eurocodes and translated (into Serbian) documents.

The Twinning project will support, within the available translation budget the translation of the annexes in the foreign languages into Montenegrin.

The exchange of the documents, which has already started before the meeting, between Montenegro and other countries in the region, will be followed and focused on.

There was a common wish expressed to establish a close co-operation between hydro-meteorological institutes of the countries represented at the meeting to support the exchange of the data and the co-operation of establishing common wind, snow and isotherm maps

It has been also agreed on a close co-operation in the area of exchange of the training, teaching materials on Eurocodes as well as publications in this area.

Personal contacts between secretaries of the technical committees in charge of Eurocodes in the region have been established.
